### **Please Pack the Following:**

- Bible, notepad, and pen
- Sleeping Bag/Blankets
- Pillow
- Towels, wash cloths
- Toiletries
- Cot/Air Mattress (you will be on the floor for a week, so an air mattress may feel better. However, if you bring an air mattress it needs to be a twin size for only one person to sleep on. If you bring anything larger than a twin size mattress, it will need to be shared between two people.)
- Water bottle that you can refill and carry with you
- Closed toe, closed heel shoes for all missions sites
- Sun protection

### **Dress Code: Ministry Sites:**

- Closed toe, closed heel shoes for all mission sites
- Modest Tops & T-shirts
- Children Sites may have Water Games– Please bring Dark tops/shirts
- Modest shorts, pants, or jeans
- Construction Sites may be asked to wear long pants

### **Dress Code: Worship Service:**

- Closed-toe or Open-toe Shoes
- Modest tops, shorts, pants, jeans, or dresses

### **Clothing Restrictions:**

- All clothing with Spaghetti/small straps, open backs, excessively short lengths, or tight fitting are unacceptable. This includes tank tops.
- Dresses and Shorts must be finger-tip length when hands are extended to the front or back of garment
